Once the tender closes we will be selecting the best provider on the basis of specific criteria and recommend that they be approved by the regulatory body for these program. This will take about three months before we can announce who will be delivering the service. However, we feel very confident that the program will be in place by Term 2 next year. I will keep you informed of the progress of this matter.


Lake MUNMORAH PUBLIC SCHOOL Community Market and Fun Might




