Lake Munmorah Public School Concert Band Program

On Wednesday night about 85 parents and children attended the information meeting regarding the School Concert Band which we will be commencing next year. Mr Phil Rutherford from the Central Coast Conservatorium of Music gave an inspiring presentation which really motivated the children to become involved. As a result, we have received 39 expressions of interest from students who want to join the band so far. This was an excellent showing of interest from our school community and will certainly mean that we will be conducting a band program in 2016. It is not too late if you want your child to join the band as long as they will be in Years 3-6 next year – just complete the expression of interest you received on Tuesday this week and return to the school office as soon as possible. It will be exciting to watch our school band develop over the coming year.

Primary Ethics – Great News

We have received 5 applications from our school community to volunteer as Ethics Teachers (4) and an Ethics Coordinator (1) for 2016. The four teacher applicants have all successfully interviewed and will commence their training in first term next year. We would be looking at starting classes in Term 2, 2016. Students who are being listed as non-scripture students on school records will be eligible to access this program. It is not available to students who are registered as attending scripture classes. This is yet again another exciting program that will commence for our students in 2016.

New Gifted and Talented Program - Yearning for Learning

As I announced yesterday in my address at the presentation assembly the school will be commencing a class for our most successful learners in Years 4 and 5. This is the first stage of building a strong gifted and talented program across the school from Years K-6. In the next 18 months, this program, which we will be calling the Yearning for Learning (Y4L), will expand across all stages, to support the learning of our most capable students in the school. Today, families of identified students in the proposed Year 4/5 class will receive a letter providing them further details about the purpose and intent of the class.

Parents as Teachers (PAT) Program

The home/school partnership is one of the essential components of an effective school. We are looking at ways to strengthen family and community engagement in student learning and achievement at our school. As a means of strengthening and enhancing the home/school learning outcomes of our students, we are introducing a Parents As Teachers (PAT) Program in 2016. The program will run throughout the 2016 school year and will cover various topics that will enable Parents to provide greater support for their child(ren) at home. The program will consist of three information sessions scheduled for weeks 3, 6 & 9 of each term. A total of twelve information sessions are currently planned for 2016, however, additional sessions may be arranged based on Parent / Teacher feedback and demand. An information flier about the program will go home with student reports next week.

Year 6 2015 Graduation

A very fitting farewell was held yesterday to say goodbye to our highly regarded Year 6 students. They have been a terrific group of student leaders this year and because of their settled behavior and their focus on learning they have set an excellent example to all of the other students across he school. I wish them well with their future lives and I know that the experiences they have enjoyed here at our school will stand them in good stead as they move into their respective high school settings. I know our teachers are particularly fond of this group and will miss having them in classrooms and around the school. I say farewell to the many families who will also finish with us as their Year 6 child finished and I thank them enormously for their positive support of the school over their time here. 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
