

Classes for 2019

I understand, in the past, the school has let students know who their teachers and classes are for the following year. While we will endeavour to keep composites and across stage classes to a minimum, it is likely there will be a 2/3 class and potentially a 4/5 class. Thanks to our student Leaders who compared the event, our Aboriginal dance and didge group who performed, and to Kindergarten for opening the show with their wonderful Christmas song.






