### Great work



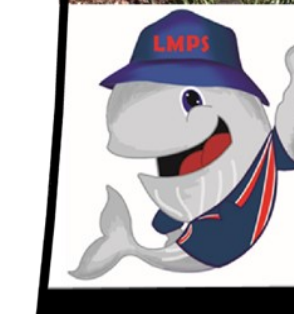

## **Year 6 Excursion Recount**

On Wednesday, 30<sup>th</sup> October 2019, Year 6 went on an excursion to Canberra. Students went to Parliament House where they sat in the Senate and re-enacted the House of Representatives. During the afternoon, students visited the War Memorial, where we participated in a memorial and learnt about the suffering and pain that Australian soldiers have experienced through war. The last stop for the day was the lookout at Mount Ainsley, where we looked down on Parliament House and the rest of Canberra.

On Thursday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2019 we visited the GeoScience where we learnt about minerals and earthquakes. At Old Parliament House students learnt about the democratic voting process, and re-enacted how the Senate operated in the past. At the Australian National Museum where we studied rocks, fossils and earthquakes. In the afternoon we went to Questacon where we participated in a simulated earthquake, watched lightening and for those who were brave enough – the giant slide!

On Friday, 1<sup>st</sup> November we went to the AIS where we were lucky enough to watch the basketballer's practicing and experienced sports simulators for wheelchair basketball and cycling. Finally we went to The Royal Australian Mint, where we learned about the history of coins, saw how money was made and saw two robots – Penny and Titan – move large buckets of money and blank coins around the mint. Overall, we had a great time, and would like to thank the teachers for taking time away from their own homes to allow us to have such a great experience.

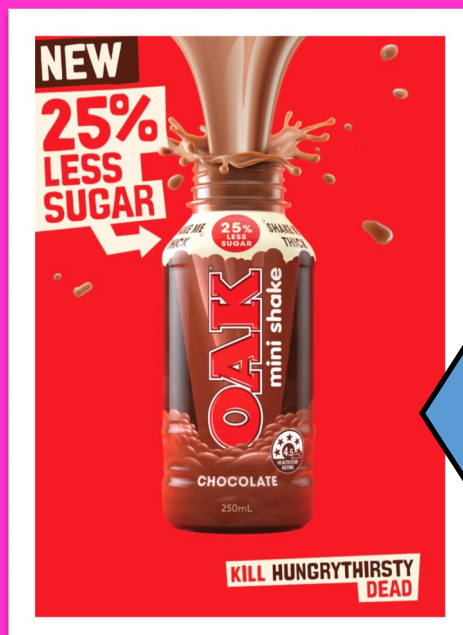
