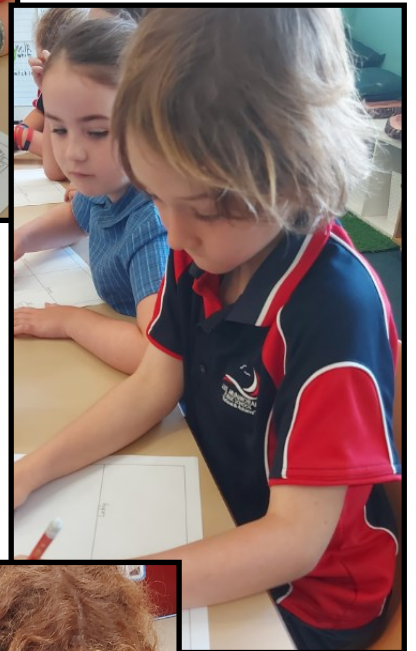
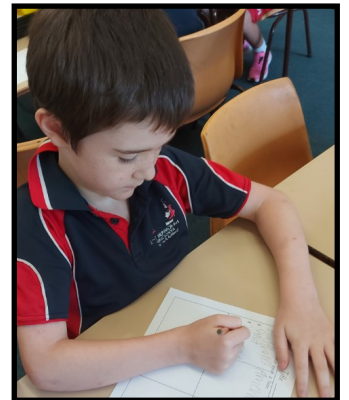

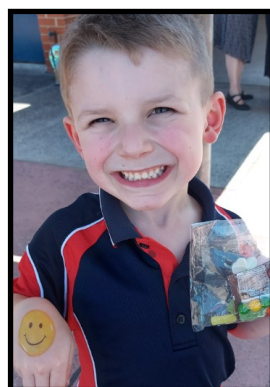
Leadership speeches

There is no more borrowing for the year.

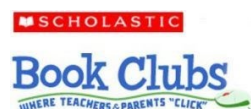
