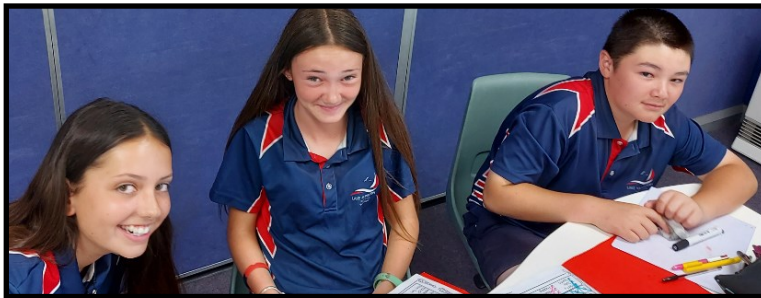


Upcoming Events

Unfortunately I had a call from BUSWAYS this week, wanting to share some recordings from the bus that travels through Lake Munmorah to Mannering Park. The vision shared with me showed some students constantly getting out of seats, walking through the bus while it was moving, throwing food/squirting water and generally being silly. Understandably the bus driver is frustrated and upset by having to consistently stop the bus and talk to the children and is fearful of what may happen if there is an occasion where brakes must be applied forcefully. The job is much more difficult when students are causing distraction to the driver. All students from this particular bus were spoken to today in regards to this.


Please discuss with your children the importance of safe bus travel: staying seated, soft voices, sensible and respectful behaviour.

This will help to get ALL students home safely.
