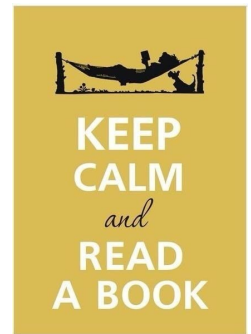

BOOK WEEK

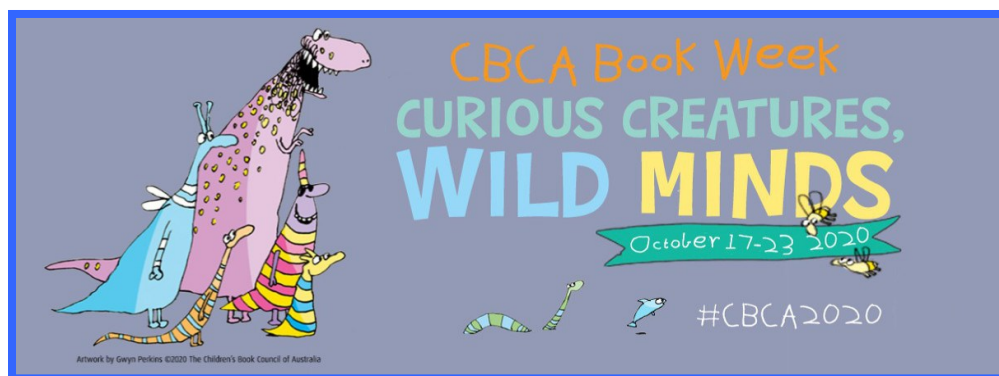
Book Week will be celebrated at LMPS from 2nd – 6th November (Term 4, Week 4).

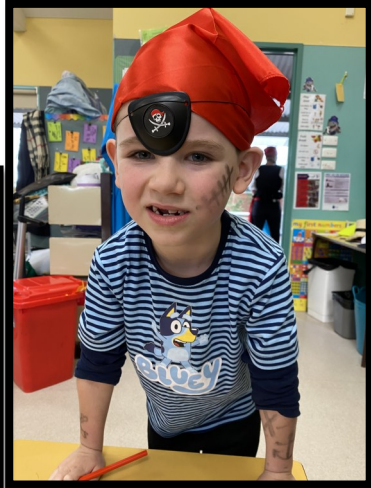
